1581. Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Racing and Gaming:

I refer to complaints and breaches of section 27(3) of the *Lotteries Commission Act 1990*. For each of the years 2020, 2021, 2022 and the first six months of 2023, will the Minister table the respective total annual numbers of:

- (a) complaints received related to alleged breaches of section 27(3) specifically related to promotion;
- (b) investigations related to alleged breaches of section 27(3) specifically related to promotion;
- (c) determined breaches of section 27(3) specifically related to promotion; and
- (d) penalties issued for breaches of section 27(3) specifically related to promotion?
