Hon Ken Travers to move -

This House notes that the Barnett/Grylls Government failed to properly consider the economic, social, environmental, and road safety impacts before deciding to close 700 kilometres of Wheatbelt rail lines. We believe this is a bad decision and it will result in thousands of additional trucks on Perth roads. We call on the Government to reverse this decision and to place a high priority on the appropriate use of rail to our ports.
