I refer to the impact of COVID-19 on the mental health of regional Western Australians, and I ask:

- (a) will the Minister please table the total number of telehealth mental health consults since December 2018, month by month, broken down by WA Country Health Service region, and where applicable, please provide data from the South Metropolitan Health Service applicable to the Peel Region?

- (g) will the Minister please table all advice provided to the Minister from her agencies in relation to the commission of the engineering assessment;
- (h) did the Public Transport Authority recommend to the Minister that an assessment should be commissioned; and
- (i) how much of the \$30 million committed by the then Labor Opposition to Tier 3 railways has been spent to date?
