1. Meeting of Council

The Council assembled at 2.00pm pursuant to order.

The President, Hon Alanna Clohesy, took the Chair.

Prayers and an Acknowledgement of Country were read.

2. Message from His Excellency the Governor — Demise of the Crown, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second and Proclamation of His Majesty King Charles the Third

The President reported the receipt of a Message from His Excellency the Governor as follows —

11 September 2022 — Message No. 22

The Governor, with deep regret, formally informs the Legislative Council of official advice provided to him that Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second passed away on 8 September 2022.

The Governor further informs the Legislative Council that his Majesty, King Charles the Third, has been proclaimed King of Australia and his other Realms and Territories, and Head of the Commonwealth, as confirmed by the Governor in Executive Council on 11 September 2022.

3. Address of Condolence — Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second

The Leader of the House moved, without notice —

That the following address be presented to His Excellency the Governor for presentation to His Majesty the King –

We, the Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia, express our deepest sympathy and condolences to Your Majesty on the death of your mother, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, and give thanks for a remarkable life dedicated to service and duty.

The motion supported by all Members including the President and was carried in silence, Members standing in their places.

4. Address of Congratulations — His Majesty King Charles the Third

The Leader of the House moved, without notice —

That the following address be presented to His Excellency the Governor for presentation to His Majesty the King –

We, the Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia, offer our sincere congratulations on Your Majesty's accession to the Throne and express the hope that Your Majesty may enjoy a long and prosperous reign.
