The Council assembled at 1.00pm pursuant to order.

The President, Hon Alanna Clohesy, took the Chair.

2. Skilled Worker Shortages

Hon Colin de Grussa: To move on the next day of sitting —

That this House —

- (a) notes with concern the ongoing issues with skilled worker shortages and the lack of equitable small business support;
- (b) discusses the need for better planning, leadership and strategies to provide long term solutions and address the immediate issues facing Western Australian businesses and industry sectors; and
- (c) calls on the Ministers for Commerce, Regional Development, Small Business, Finance and State Development to work together and proactively resolve these issues.

3. Western Australia's Public Health System

Motion No. 3 having been called, Hon Tjorn Sibma, pursuant to notice, moved —

That this House —

- (a) expresses concern at the measurable decline in the capacity and performance of Western Australia's public health system;
- (b) registers its respect for the performance of the State's frontline clinical staff despite the McGowan Government's continued mismanagement of the health portfolio;
- (c) notes the lack of confidence in the Minister for Health, the Hon Roger Cook, expressed by medical professionals and the broader community; and
- (d) acquaints the Legislative Assembly accordingly.
