

NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

1. COVID-19 Pandemic

Hon Tjorn Sibma: To move —

That this House urges the McGowan Government to —

- (a) justify why and on what grounds it has abandoned a COVID-19 suppression strategy in favour of an elimination strategy;
- (b) regularly publish official information (including public health information) underpinning all of its major COVID-19 decisions;
- (c) permit key officials including the Chief Health Officer and the Police Commissioner, to regularly brief the public on COVID-19 matters;
- (d) explain apparent inconsistencies with quarantine exemptions granted over the course of the pandemic;
- (e) table its plan for, and advise its preparedness to manage, a potential secondwave outbreak; and
- (f) respect Western Australian's suffering isolation from their loved ones located throughout Australia and overseas.
