Hon Simon O'Brien continued his introductory remarks in moving the following motion -

That this House -

Recalls the Labor Party's pre-election claims that it "understood the public health system" and "would fix the health system" and calls upon the Government to explain -

- (a) why the State's health system is under more pressure now than it was in February 2001, especially in relation to staffing;
- (b) why it has cut back rural health services;
- (c) why the Minister for Health will not support an MRI scanner for the Southern Metropolitan Area;
- (d) the failure to obtain a PET scanner;

- (e) why it has halved funding for the Central Waitlist Bureau;
- (f) why it has sacked country hospital boards;
- (g) the inadequacy of emergency services to outer suburban areas; and
- (h) the inadequacy of funding for health services generally.

Want of Quorum

There not being a quorum present, the Deputy President gave instructions for the ringing of the Bells. A quorum being formed, Hon Simon O'Brien continued his introductory remarks. *Interruption of Debate* [SO 195].
