- (1) In relation to sheep being taken to the Department of Agriculture and Food office in South Perth for autopsy on 4 August 2010, I ask:
 - (a) what is the progress of the complaint which was lodged with the Animal Welfare Unit (AWU) Inspectorate on 4 August 2010 concerning three incidents alleging animal cruelty to sheep, reported to the AWU by Animal Angels?
- (2) In relation to an investigation involving Peel Petfoods, that was primarily undertaken by the Department of Local Government with assistance from two senior Western Australia Police detectives, I ask:
 - (a) what is the progress of the complaint which was lodged in December 2009 by the Animals' Angels to the AWU Inspectorate concerning unfit animals which had been rejected from live export at the Port of Fremantle?
- (3) In relation to an investigation report by the Australia Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS), and a possible contravention of the *Animal Welfare Act 2002*, I ask:
 - (a) what is the progress of the complaint lodged by Animals Australia on 27 February 2011 with the AWU Inspectorate, concerning the treatment of sheep shipped on a live export voyage in June 2010, which was to have been progressed by the Department of Agriculture and Food when the Liberal National Government implemented the new arrangements for animal welfare on 1 July 2011?

6065. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Agriculture and Food

In relation to the recent announcement of collaboration between the State Government and the Grains Research Development Corporation (GRDC) to fund the Australian Export Grains Innovation Centre (AEGIC), I ask:

- (a) will the AEGIC facility be built on the same site as the new redeveloped Department of Agriculture and Food headquarters in South Perth; and
 - (i) if not, where will the new centre be located and will it be built on land owned by the State Government; and
 - (ii) if the centre is to be located on Government land, what is the cost to the State Government?

6066. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Transport

I refer to the recent announcement, on 1 August 2011, that the State Government will provide \$35 million for 31 road safety projects across Western Australia in 2011-12, and specifically to the \$1.5 million for widening and sealing shoulders and installing a guard rail over nine miles on the Roelands Hill section of Coalfields Highway, and I ask:

- (a) using the intersection of South West and Coalfields Highway as a start point, at which kilometre pegs will this work commence and finish;
- (b) will this work be continued for nine kilometres or will it be broken up;
- (c) if the work is not to be completed in a continuous length on the highway, at which kilometre pegs will the work be done between;
- (d) when will the work begin; and
- (e) when will the work finish?
