1. Dedicated focus on children in this State

Hon Donna Faragher to move —

- (a) the Joint Standing Committee on the Commissioner for Children and Young People, in its *Report 6: Hungry for Change: Addressing food insecurity for children and young people affected by poverty*, stated "there appears to be a degree of policy incoherence and invisibility in relation to many of the issues that impact children";
- (b) the Joint Standing Committee's concerns have been reiterated in its most recent report, Report 9: Pathways to Thriving: Enhancing support for humanitarian children and young people in Western Australia;
- (c) the concerning lack of action by the Cook Labor Government in relation to many issues impacting Western Australia's children; and

calls on the cook Labor Government to ensure there is a dedicated focus on children in this State.
