### 1. Meeting of Council

Hon Ken Travers presented a petition, by delivery to the Clerk, [SO 130], from 151 petitioners requesting the Legislative Council investigate the process for awarding Transperth Service Contracts for bus operators and whether any money will be saved under proposed new contracts.
