### Appropriation (Recurrent 2022-23) Bill 2022

(Treasurer) (No. 72)

The purpose of this Bill is to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the recurrent services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 2023.

Consideration of Estimates Committees Reports.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### Appropriation (Capital 2022-23) Bill 2022

(Treasurer) (No. 71)

The purpose of this Bill is to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital services of the year ending 30 June 2023.

Consideration of Estimates Committees Reports.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### Charitable Trusts Bill 2022

(Attorney General) (No. 68)

The purpose of this Bill is to affect the law relating to charitable trusts; and to repeal the *Charitable Trusts Act 1962*; and to make a consequential amendment to the *Freedom of Information Act 1992*.

Second reading, debated and agreed.

Consideration in detail and amended.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### Bail Amendent Bill 2022

(Attorney General) (No. 74)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the *Bail Act 1982*.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered, debate adjourned.

### Mining Amendent Bill 2021

(Minister for Mines and Petroleum) (No. 49)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the *Mining Act 1978*.

Second reading, debated and adjourned.
