NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

1. **Misuse of Drugs Amendment Bill 2021** (*Notice given 1 June 2021*)

Hon Dr Brian Walker: To move —

That a Bill for “An Act to amend the *Misuse of Drugs Act 1981*.” be introduced and read a first time.

2. **Cannabis Decriminalisation**

Hon Sophia Moermond: To move —

That this House calls upon the McGowan Government to reintroduce the cannabis decriminalisation measures contained in the *Cannabis Control Act 2003*, as introduced and supported by the Labor Government of the day, ahead of conducting a detailed investigation into the potential to fully legalise cannabis here in Western Australia.
