**146. Hon Neil Thomson to the Minister for Mental Health representing the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the practice of Western Australian hospitals declaring a Code Yellow when a hospital has either an infrastructure or other internal emergency which will affect its service delivery, and I ask:

- (a) how many Code Yellows have been called at hospitals or health campuses in Western Australia in the past 12 months; and
- (b) which hospitals called a Code Yellow and, on what specific dates, in the last 12 months?

**147. Hon Steve Martin to the Minister for Mental Health representing the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the practice within our health system where clinical incidents are classified, and I specifically refer to those incidents categorised as severity assessment code 1, where a clinical incident that has or could have caused harm or death and which is attributed to health care provision or lack thereof rather than the patient's underlying condition or illness, and I ask:

- (a) for each metropolitan and regional hospital, how many severity assessment code 1 events have taken place in the following years:
  - (i) 2017-2018;
  - (ii) 2018-2019;
  - (iii) 2019-2020; and
  - (iv) 2020 to date; and
- (b) of those severity assessment code 1 events reported each year in (a)(i)-(iv), how many resulted in death in:
  - (i) 2017-2018;
  - (ii) 2018-2019;
  - (iii) 2019-2020; and
  - (iv) 2020 to date?
