The FHRI Fund Advisory Council (the Council) is proud to announce that by the close of 2023, the FHRI Fund awarded more than \$100 million in grants across the WA health and medical research and innovation sector (Sector).

The December Council meeting was focused on finalising a schedule of programs and initiatives to be developed and launched over the next four years. Investing in health and medical research and innovation platforms to enable cutting edge research, translation and commercialisation and ensuring that funding is available for health and medical research and innovation at all stages of career pipelines, were key priorities.

The Council was delighted to hear from the WA Chapter of the Australian Association for Medical Research Institutes (AAMRI WA), and to discuss strategies to maximise the impact and benefit of the FHRI Fund for the Sector.

Looking ahead, 2024 is set to be a busy year for the Council with an evaluation of the first 3 years of the FHRI Fund and commencement of planning for the next FHRI Fund Strategy and set of Priority Goals due to commence.
